**EWI Restates 2007 Results**

Ajax, Ontario, CANADA - (May 6, 2009) - On April 17, 2009 Environmental Waste International Inc. (EWI) (TSX-V: EWS) reported that its audited 2008 Financial Statements would be filed based on the view that EWI could be considered the primary beneficiary of Environmental Waste International Limited Partnership (EWILP), a Variable Interest Entity (VIE). Under these circumstances, Accounting Guideline 15 required consolidation of EWILP. In the 2008 statements filed on SEDAR on April 30, 2009, EWI consolidated EWILP's financial results. EWI also restated its 2007 financial results to reflect the same treatment of EWILP. The restated numbers for 2007 are viewed as a refiling of the original 2007 statement results. Please refer to notes 3(b), 11 and 12 of the EWI audited 2008 financial statements for more detailed explanations.

EWI designs and builds systems for the breakdown of specific organic waste, including rubber tires, medical waste, biological effluents and food waste.
