Re: CSA Proposed Amendments Relating to the Offering Memorandum Exemption

Dear Madams:

I am writing to comment on the proposed amendments to NI 45-106, in particular the proposed annual investment limits for non-accredited investors.

I am an Exempt Market Product customer. I have held this type investment for seven years. I have a number of different types of these investments to diversify my portfolio. I experienced large volatility and eventual large losses in the public market from 2000 to 2007. I was fed up with this volatility and found exempt market products gave me the stability so that when some foreign country is in financial hard times, I do not have to worry about my financial investments.

I oppose any bureaucratic government agency telling me how much I can invest in any type of investment whether that is stocks, mutual funds, exempt market products or real estate. It is my money not yours. It is my risk and I demand the freedom to invest as I please. If my financial advisor gives me false information about an investment, I have recourse. Maybe I should have the same recourse with bureaucrats that restrict me from investing where I want to.

I am expecting to have a Walton land investment to pay out in a year or so. I fully expect to have the right to reinvest all of this into another project without restriction.
