Re: Part IV Amendments – Adding Website Disclosure Requirements - new section 473

1. **Adding the Management Information Circular**

One of the most important documents that an investor reviews when making an investment is the Management Information Circular. I am involved in Private Equity investments and this document is of utmost importance. However it's difficult to obtain unless one specifically requests it; or search for it on SEDAR. The search for this document on SEDAR is not easy. I therefore recommend that this document be **absolutely required** for the new section 473 website disclosures.

2. **Adding the Notice of Annual or Special Meeting of Shareholders**

Finding out when/where there is an Annual Meeting of Shareholders **is one of the most difficult things to acquire.** When you check the website, there is seldom any information (although a few companies do post this info.). When you call the company for this info, the receptionists seldom have this information and you are given the runaround to call back. Most companies treat this as a non-important request and a nuisance; and are often not helpful in providing same. However as an investor, it is useful to attend these vital meetings in order to assess/evaluate a company and its management. Finding this information on SEDAR is cumbersome, and it is seldom posted in a timely manner, so that one can attend the annual meeting. I therefore recommend that this be also **absolutely required information** for the new section 473 website disclosures.
