## **TEMPORARY ORDER** ((Subsection 127(7) or 127(8))

**WHEREAS** on November 21, 2014, the Ontario Securities Commission (the "Commission") issued a temporary order, pursuant to subsections 127(1) and 127(5) of the *Securities Act*, R.S.O., c. S.5., as amended (the "Act"), ordering the following:

- that all trading in any securities by 7997698 Canada Inc., carrying on business as International Legal and Accounting Services Inc., World Incubation Centre, or WIC (ON) ("7997698"), John Lee also known as Chin Lee ("Lee"), and Mary Huang also known as Ning-Sheng Mary Huang ("Huang") shall cease; and
- 2. that the exemptions contained in Ontario securities law do not apply to any of 7997698, Lee, and Huang (the "Temporary Order");

**AND WHEREAS** on November 21, 2014, the Commission ordered that the Temporary Order shall expire on the 15<sup>th</sup> day after its making unless extended by order of the Commission;

**AND WHEREAS** on November 24, 2014, the Commission issued a Notice of Hearing to consider, among other things, the extension of the Temporary Order, to be held on Wednesday December 3, 2014, at 10:00 a.m. (the "Notice of Hearing");

**AND WHEREAS** the Notice of Hearing set out that the hearing was to consider, among other things, whether, in the opinion of the Commission, it was in the public interest, pursuant to

subsections 127(7) and 127(8) of the Act, to extend the Temporary Order until the conclusion of

the hearing or until such further time as considered necessary by the Commission;

**AND WHEREAS** Staff of the Commission ("Staff") served the Respondents with copies

of the Temporary Order, the Notice of Hearing, the Hearing Brief, the Supplementary Hearing

Brief, and Staff's Written Submissions and Brief of Authorities as evidenced by the Affidavits of

Service sworn by Steve Carpenter on December 1, 2014, and December 2, 2014, and filed with

the Commission:

**AND WHEREAS** the Commission held a hearing on December 3, 2014, at which Lee

attended but Huang did not attend although properly served;

AND WHEREAS the Commission heard submissions from counsel for Staff and from

Lee on his own behalf and on behalf of 7997698 and Huang;

**AND WHEREAS** the Commission is of the opinion that it is in the public interest to

make this Order;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Temporary Order is extended to June 3, 2015; and

specifically:

1. that all trading in any securities by 7997698, Lee, and Huang shall cease; and

2. that the exemptions contained in Ontario securities law do not apply to any of

7997698, Lee, and Huang; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Hearing is adjourned to Wednesday, May 27,

2015, at 10:00 a.m or such other date as may be determined by the Office of the Secretary.
